**Pisco is given full official recognition as a Peruvian denomination of origin.**

**SUPREME DECREE No. 001-01-ICTI/TKD**

**THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC**

**CONSIDERING**

That, it is arrangement and tradition in Peru the denomination of origin Pisco, for designation of the grape spirit, whose peruanity is irrefutable and consubstantial to its own nationality.

That, in accordance with what was requested in the previous recital, the National Institute of Culture has declared the denomination of origin Pisco Cultural Heritage of the Nation, through Chief Resolution No. 179;

That, also under the protection of the provisions of Supreme Decree No. 023-90-CTI/IND, of 24 July 1990, has been issued Directorial Resolution No. 072087-DIPI of 12 December 1990, which recognizes as Denomination of Origin Pisco for products obtained by the distillation of wines, resulting from the exclusive fermentation of ripe grapes, obtained on the coast of the departments of Lima, Ica, Arequipa, Moquegua and the Valleys of Locumba, Sama and Caplina of the department of Tacna;

That, consequently, it is necessary to contribute to the relevance that this Denomination of Origin deserves;

In accordance with the provisions of Article 211, Paragraph 11 of the Political Constitution of Peru;

## **PROVIDES**

Article 1.- Give full official recognition to Pisco as a Peruvian denomination of origin for products obtained of the distillation of wines, resulting from the exclusive fermentation of ripe grapes, obtained on the coast of the departments of Lima, Ica, Arequipa, Moquegua and the Valleys of Locumba, Sama and Caplina in the department of Tacna, ratifying in all its extremes Directorial Resolution No. 072087-DIPI issued by the Directorate of Industrial Property of the "Research Institute of Industrial Technology and Technical Standards" - ITINTEC.

Article 2. - Provide that the Vice Ministry of Tourism of the Ministry of Industry, Domestic Trade, Tourism and Integration, in coordination with the public and private sectors promote its use through the various festivities that take place in the country, as well as in the promotion of tourism by interprovincial and international transport agencies and companies.

Given at the Government House, in Lima, on the sixteenth day of January of the year nineteen hundred and ninety-one.
